## DAY 1 – ORCHARD ROAD

- 1000:** If you fancy a read in the morning, check out Borders at Wheelock Place and do some browsing. Then head to the neighbouring Liat Towers where you can shop to your heart's content at Zara and the more upscale Massimo Dutti. A little farther is The Shopping Gallery at Hilton Hotel where you can find irresistible designer goods.
- 1200:** Cross over to Tangs for great local and imported fashion finds. It's also a good place to update your stash of beauty products.
